Gym membership consisting of both residential clientele and external clients has increased to approximately 180 users every week, plus 65 staff.

The flooring is perfect for the many different types of clients eg wheelchair and zimmer frame users, amputees and clients recovering from bone fractures or hip replacements, stroke sufferers all who are often very unsteady on their feet and require the assurance of a non slip surface that has a softer impact for damaged or sensitive limbs.

Ten years on, the flooring still looks good, is very durable, easy to keep clean and lives up to it's name being "tuff and flexible".

I have been with the Trust nearly 11 years and in that time there has not been any maintenance required to the flooring.

I have no hesitation in recommending Tuflex Rubber Flooring to any prospective purchaser who maybe considering the installation of this product.
